

### Expectations

Homework checks will be given (about) every three days. Points earned will be based on correct answers and required work/calculations.
- \* Projects may be assigned during the year, and their worth will be explained at the time of the assignment.
- \* Please note that cheating will not be tolerated and will result in a zero on the test, quiz or assignment as well as a referral to the VPO. This includes homework/classwork assignments!

- ◇ Absence from class, even if it is a partial absence or an absence due to a field trip, meeting or a guidance appointment, does not excuse you from homework, quizzes or tests.
