

Expectations

- Be prepared for class each day, and as soon as the bell rings. This means coming to class on time and having the required materials with you:

- Complete problems as (or even before) I work them. Don't just sit here and watch!

- Be here the day of a quiz or a test.
- You will not be permitted to leave the room for any reason unless you have a pass book. Please try to use the bathroom or visit your locker between classes.

- * Tests will generally be announced a week before they are given. You will have two to three **cumulative** tests during a nine week period.
- * Quizzes will be given regularly, and they will not always be announced!
- * Homework and/or classwork will be assigned daily. Answers to homework assignments will be posted online, and you are expected to check your answers and rework missed problems **before** the next class. Homework checks will be given (about) every three days. Points earned will be based on correct answers and required work/calculations.
- * Projects may be assigned during the year, and their worth will be explained at the time of the assignment.
- * Please note that cheating will not be tolerated and will result in a zero on the test, quiz or assignment as well as a referral to the VPO. This includes homework/classwork assignments!

- ◇ Absence from class, even if it is a partial absence or an absence due to a field trip, meeting or a guidance appointment, does not excuse you from homework, quizzes or tests.
